Congratulations on your acceptance to the Master of Science in Pharmacy with a concentration in Medication & Therapy Management! As a new student we expect that you are eager to begin mapping out your journey.

The MTM courses run during the A term (first 6-7 weeks) or B term (last 6-7 weeks) of the Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters. Each course is only offered in the A or B term, not both. For example, the Endocrine course (PHA 6634) is only offered in the B term. The core required Foundational courses are offered every semester (Spring, Summer, and Fall).

Core-Required Courses

Core-Required Courses must be completed in your first semester as a student in the program.

Required Courses

There will be two to four “Required” courses offered each semester. After completing PHA6631 in the first half of the first semester students will take PHA6632 in the second half of the semester plus will be able to start required courses as well. “Required” courses are offered on an **ever-other semester** basis (For example: PHA6633 would be offered in Spring A 2021, Fall A 2021, then Summer A 2022). Graduation

- 33 credits are required to complete the degree.
- Only courses completed with a grade of C or higher can be counted toward the degree.
- You must maintain a 3.00 GPA or higher to graduate.
- You also must “apply” to graduate during your last semester of the program
- Upon completion of the program, graduates will earn a Master of Science in Pharmacy with a major in Pharmaceutical Sciences and a concentration in Medication Therapy Management issued by the Graduate School of the University of Florida. Your transcript will read Master of Science in Pharmacy, graduation date, major Pharmaceutical Sciences - Medication Therapy Management. Your diploma will read Master of Science in Pharmacy, major Pharmaceutical Sciences.
