The MTM courses run during the A term (first 8 weeks) or B term (last 8 weeks) of the Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters. Each course is only offered in the A or B term, not both. For example, the Endocrine course (PHA 6634) is only offered in the B term. The core-required Foundations courses are offered every semester (Spring, Summer, and Fall).

Core-Required Courses

Core-Required Courses must be completed in your first semester and before the Required Courses.

Required Courses

Two to four Required Courses are offered each semester. After completing PHA 6631 and PHA 6632 in the first semester, students track into the required courses offered in the following semester. Students then rotate through the sequence of required courses offered each semester. Since the required courses rotate, they are not offered every semester. MTM: Capstone and MTM: Final Comprehensive Exam must be taken in the final semester.

Graduation

- 33 credits are required to complete the degree.
- Only courses completed with a grade of C or higher can be counted toward the degree.
- You must maintain a 3.00 GPA or higher to graduate.
- Upon completion of the program, graduates will earn a Master of Science in Pharmacy with a major in Pharmaceutical Sciences and a concentration in Medication Therapy Management issued by the Graduate School of the University of Florida. Your transcript will read Master of Science in Pharmacy, graduation date, major Pharmaceutical Sciences - Medication Therapy Management. Your diploma will read Master of Science in Pharmacy, major Pharmaceutical Sciences.
